# Q10 If you don't have computer access at home, do you have access to a computer some place near your home (school, relative's home, neighbor, library, etc)?



# Q11 If you don't have Internet access at home, do you have access to the Internet some place near your home (school, relative's home, neighbor, library, etc.)?



# Q15 Do you use PowerSchool (District Student Information System) to monitor middle school or high school student progress?


